

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(C131 POOL HEY LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C131 Pool Hey Lane from a point 25m South West of the level crossing for a distance of 50m in a North Easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0005 hours until 0530 hours on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2021 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C131 Pool Hey Lane, Scarisbrick – C136 Wyke Road, Scarisbrick –  
C136 Wyke Cop Road, Scarisbrick – C136 Snape Green,  
Scarisbrick – A570 Southport Road, Scarisbrick – C131 Pool Hey Lane,  
Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the annual level crossing service to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
