(U275 BLACK MOSS LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U275 Black Moss Lane, Scarisbrick from A570 Southport Road, Scarisbrick for a distance of 170m in a North Westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 7th March 2022 until 1600 hours on Monday 2nd May 2022 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Access for vehicles in excess of 7.5t will be permitted through the closure area due to 7.5t weight restriction beyond Booker Food Services.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A570 Southport Road, Scarisbrick – B5243 Jacksmere Lane,
Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow infrastructure installation and footway construction works to be carried out by Road Safety Services in conjunction with Eccleston Homes Ltd.
