(C110 SMITHY LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C110 Smithy Lane, Scarisbrick from a point approximately 105m South West of its junction with B5242 Heatons Bridge Road, Scarisbrick for a distance of approximately 90m in a South Westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Monday 30th May 2022 until 1500 hours on Friday 3rd June 2022 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5242 Heatons Bridge Road, Scarisbrick – C133 Moorfield Lane,
Scarisbrick – C133 Narrow Moss Lane, Scarisbrick – C133 Narrow
Moss Lane, Ormskirk – U1070 Heskin Lane, Ormskirk – A570
Southport Road, Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow investigatory works of a water pump to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
