

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(C131 POOL HEY LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of C131 Pool Hey Lane, Scarisbrick from a point 405m South West of its junction with C136 Wyke Road, Scarisbrick for a distance of 375m in a South Westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0020 hours until 0530 hours on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C136 Wyke Road, Scarisbrick – C136 Wyke Cop Road, Scarisbrick –  
C136 Snape Green, Scarisbrick – A570 Southport Road, Scarisbrick  
and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the annual level crossing test to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
