(HALL ROAD, SCARISBRICK, DAM WOOD LANE, SCARISBRICK, HEATONS BRIDGE ROAD, SCARISBRICK, BARRISON GREEN, SCARISBRICK AND PIPPIN STREET, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the West Lancashire Borough:-
 - i. Hall Road, Scarisbrick from Bescar Brow Lane, Scarisbrick to Dam Wood Lane, Scarisbrick.
 - ii. Dam Wood Lane, Scarisbrick from Hall Road, Scarisbrick to Heatons Bridge Road, Scarisbrick.
 - iii. Heatons Bridge Road, Scarisbrick from Dam Wood Lane, Scarisbrick to Barrison Green, Scarisbrick.
 - iv. Barrison Green, Scarisbrick from Heatons Bridge Road, Scarisbrick to Pippin Street, Burscough.
 - v. Pippin Street, Burscough from Barrison Green, Scarisbrick to Tollgate Road, Burscough.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1500 hours from Wednesday 4th January 2023 until Wednesday 18th January 2023 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for school bus services will be accommodated.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bescar Brow Lane, Scarisbrick – Southport Road, Scarisbrick – Southport Road, Ormskirk – County Road, Ormskirk – High Lane, Ormskirk – Pippin Street, Burscough and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing patching works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
